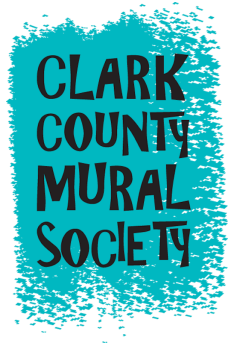


CALL TO ARTIST

2019 Special Project 2



THEME - Promoting America's Vancouver

The port seeks a mural that:

- Is interactive
- Could feature a historic Vancouver waterfront scene
- Could feature a scene from the port's original warehouse at Terminal 1 which stood on this location
- Could feature a "welcome to Vancouver" message
- The mural should appeal to residents and visitors alike

DETAILS

The Port of Vancouver is seeking a mural to enliven an exterior blank wall at its Terminal 1 property on the Vancouver waterfront. The wall measures approximately 20 ft. high X 60 ft. long. It is on the exterior of what was formerly a Red Lion hotel. The surface is wood siding.

The American Empress paddleboat currently docks at this location and embarks and disembarks 220 guests several times a month from March through early December. We would like a mural that tourists could engage in and be photographed in so we can help market Terminal 1 and Vancouver to a much wider audience. There are also increasing numbers of people walking up and down the new Vancouver waterfront and we would like to engage these people as well.

The port can share historic photos of the original Terminal 1 warehouse that was on this property if the artist is interested.

The port is in the process of redeveloping this property and has plans to demolish the building in late 2020. The mural would thus be of a temporary nature and will most likely not be saved in the demolition.

Compensation - Artist to submit paint requirements and artist fee (CCMS will take care of wall preparation costs and necessary scaffolding costs).

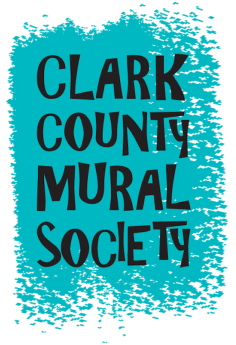
Timeline - Final Entry Deadline: August 15th. Artist Announced: August 22nd.

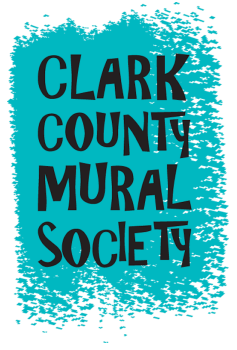
