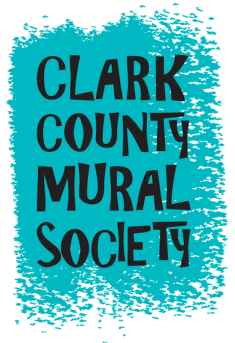


CALL TO ARTIST

2020 Summer of Murals



THEME - International Diversity

The Clark County Mural society will partner up with the City of Vancouver and Fourth Plain Forward to celebrate the diverse cultures of the Fourth Plain Corridor "International District." The Fourth Plain Corridor is a socially and economically diverse community, and has long been known as Vancouver's "International District." Diversity is reflected in the residents that live and work nearby, and in the businesses that line the corridor, including restaurants that serve international cuisine, ethnic food markets, and culturally specific service providers. Like the businesses mentioned above, competitive submissions will reflect the diverse culture heritage of the area, and connect with and/or celebrate the international food, culture, music, art, and heritage of Fourth Plain residents.

It is up to the discretion of the artist(s) to decide how and what to integrate in regard to the theme.

Applicants must include the following materials as part of their proposal:

- Completed Artist Waiver Form from the Application Packet
- A brief description and a color illustration of the proposed mural. The medium is Outdoor paint and must work when covered by sealant and anti-graffiti coatings and approximate dimensions of the proposed mural.
- Estimated project budget including time and materials,
- Assuming a July start, please provide an estimated timeline for project completion Request for Proposal (RFP) should be emailed as a PDF to: pmsupervisor@ccmurals.org

DETAILS

Compensation - \$3,000 per mural

Time Line -

- JUNE 1st, 2020, Announcement and distribution of RFP
- June 21st Deadline for submitting proposals
- June 22-25. All submissions reviewed and Semi-finalists selected.
- June 26-30, Artist selected and Forms completed. (Finalists selection)
- Walls prepped (power washed) JUNE 25th-30
- June 27-30 Artist Orientation and paint order. TBA
- July 1 Work begins (schedule TBD with artist)
- August 29 Work completed. (TBD with artist)

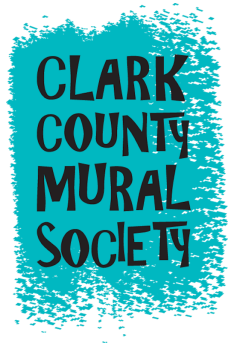

Finalists will be considered based on meeting the following criteria:

- Artist met the requirements outlined in the RFP; the proposal was submitted by the deadline
- Attention to the theme
- Originality and creativity
- Evidence of ability to create large scale, distinct work
- Ability to maintain project timelines and budgets
